About Goalpara

Goalpara, one of the oldest towns of Assam is situated on the south bank of the river Brahmaputra. It has the pride of having the 2th Municipality in the State way back in 1875. Call for paper

Faculties, researchers, and trainees from the research and educational institutes /organizations as well as industries are invited to submit Abstract of Research Papers based on original research work (within 300 words). The abstract should include a title of the research paper (sentence case and letter in 14 font size with middle alignment) followed by the name of the author(s) and affiliation with email (Font-Times New Roman, size-12). The name of the presenting author should be underlined. The abstract should be sent through email (ascisocglp15@gmail.com) only on or before 15th December, 2015. The text should contain a brief introduction, material and methods, results and discussion (without giving subheadings and references). The acceptance of the abstract will be conveyed by e-mail only. Authors should submit their abstract along with filled in Registration Form and registration fees before the deadline. Abstract submitted after the deadline will not be published in the Abstract volume. The authors should indicate the Sub-theme under which he/she prefers to present the research paper. For submission of full length paper, authors are requested to follow the format of JASS, the Research Journal of the Assam Science Society. The full paper may be submitted on or before December 31, 2015. The papers presented in the seminar will be published in the peer reviewed Proceeding of the society with ISBN number.
